

venue Farringdon Street

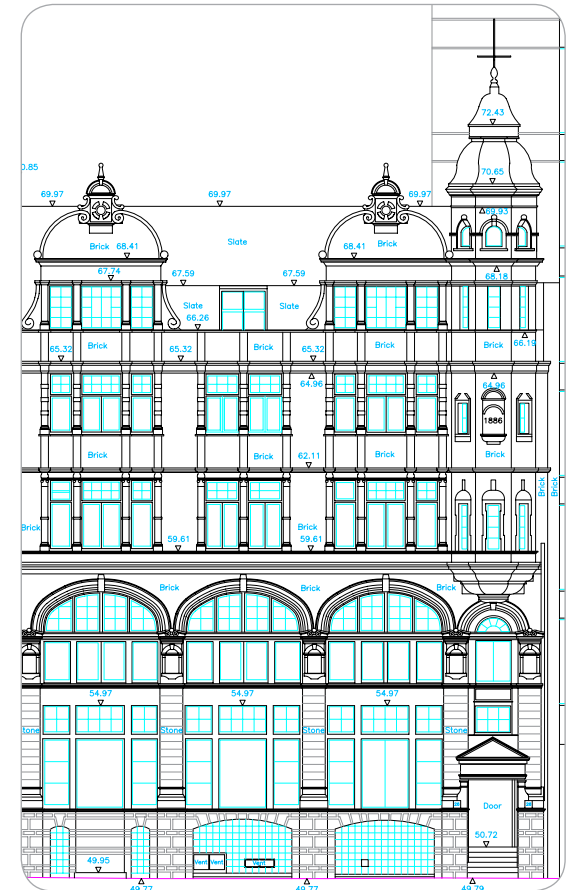


an impressive red brick and stone facade characterises this grade-II 1886 listed victorian building situated among the mid- to late nineteenth century architecture lining farringdon street in the city of london. used until recently to house office space, the building is undergoing gradual stripping back to and restoration of its key internal period features. offered for event, filming and stills hire during and after this process.

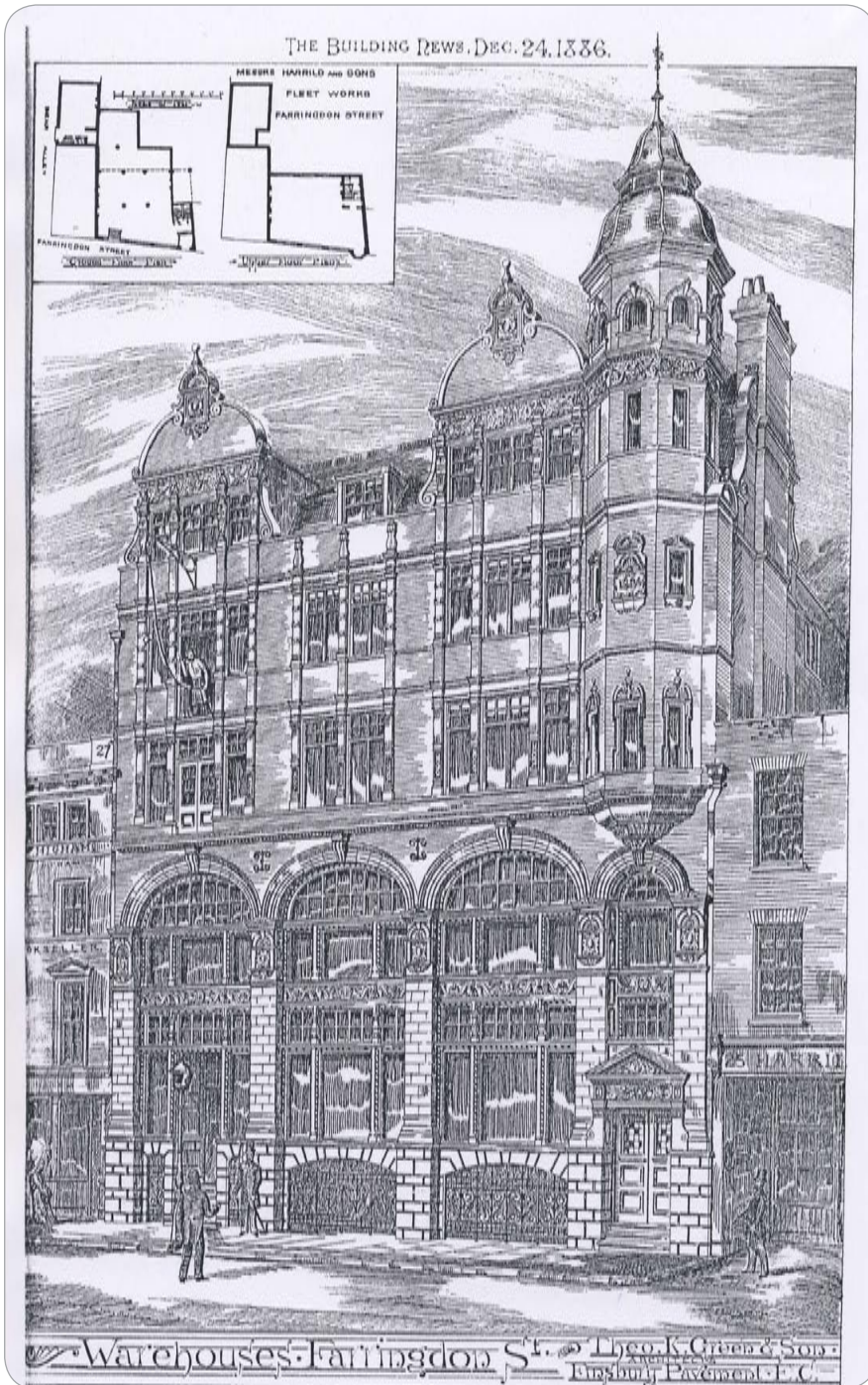
with a generous ground floor, basement and four upper floors, a site visit is best advised to see the building's current state of works and for you to uncover what inspiration you find, be it stark backdrops of an architectural carcass, focusing on period features as they re-emerge or utilising the wonderful period facade. natural light is plentiful with ac power and wcs also available.

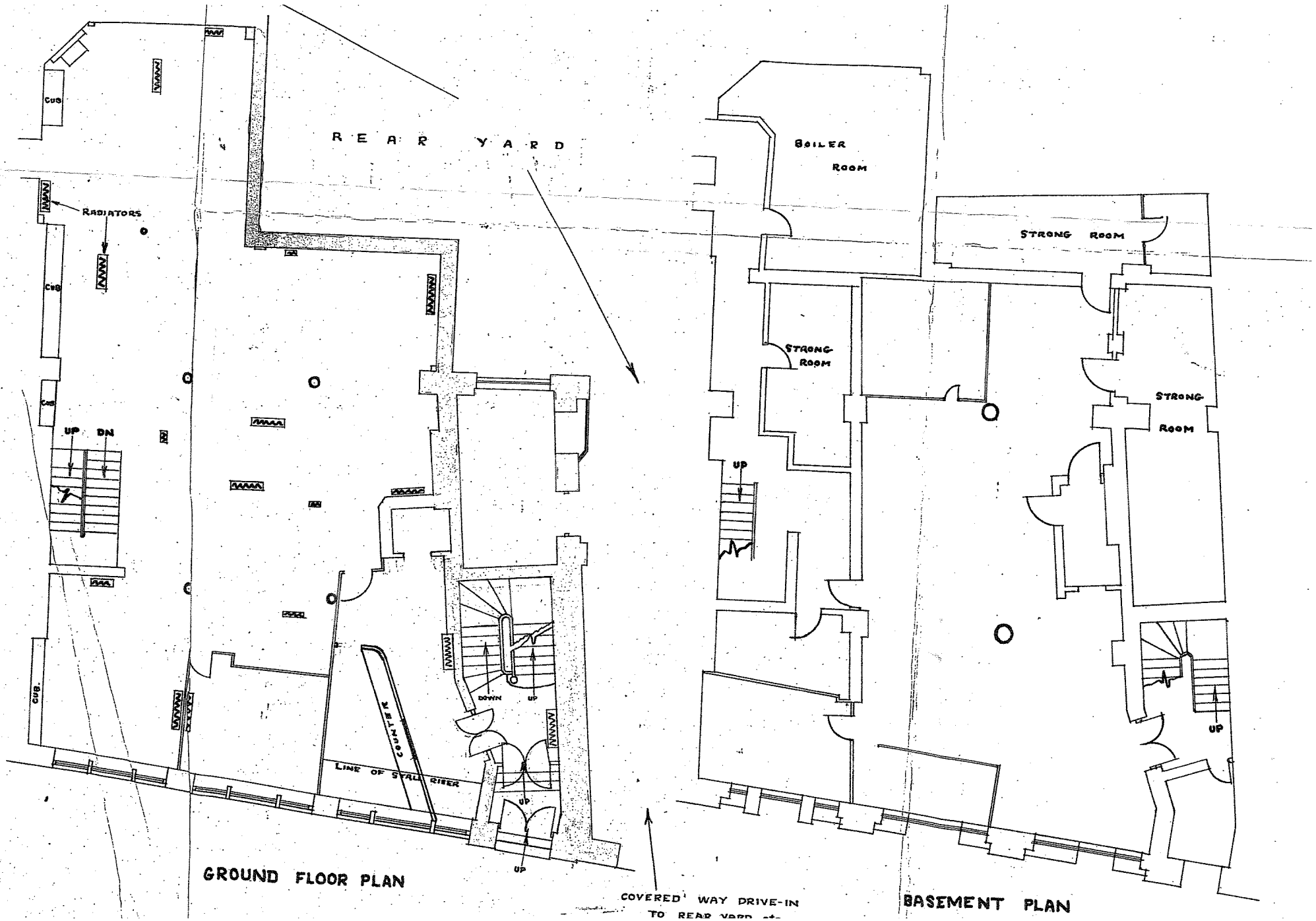


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left: the 1886 building in its first incarnation as a warehouse

right: floorplans - note the ground floor can be made available stripped to become a completely open space.

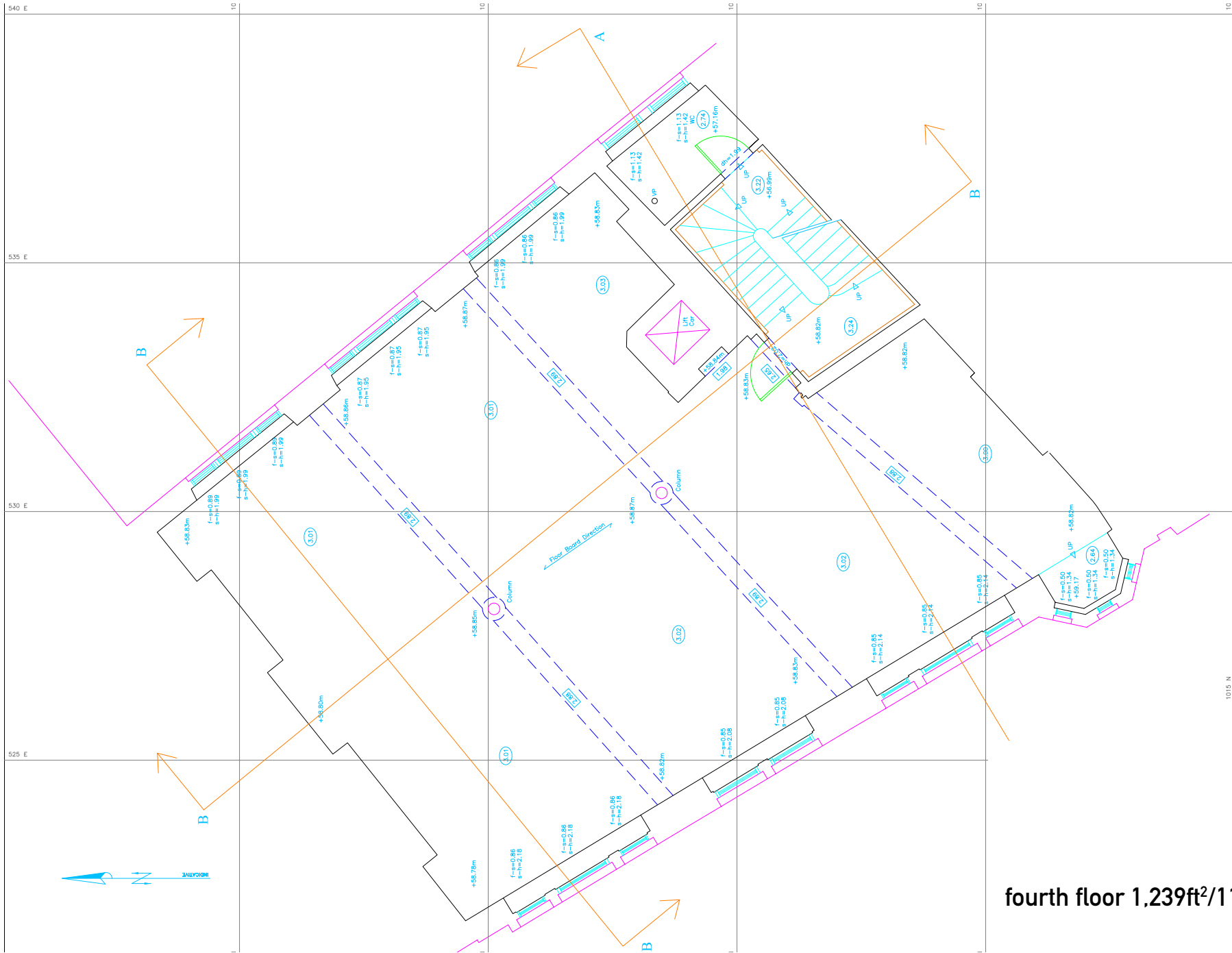


ground floor 2,085ft²/194m²
